Curriculum coverage, statutory requirements:



explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive



identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other



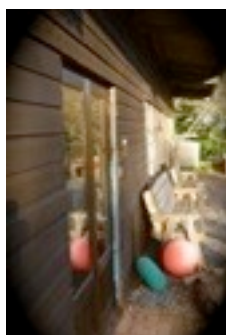
identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including micro-habitats



describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food

Directions: From Kingsbridge direction at Stokenham on the A379 take the right turn at the roundabout signposted to the lighthouse. After about a mile and a half there is a left turn to Beesands and Beeson. Take this turning and then take the immediate right. At the brow of the hill we are on the left.
