Visit us and learn in a beautiful woodland setting on an organic farm a mile from the beach at Beesands. Explore the woodland and use our 'outdoor lab' to analyse findings. Investigate pollinators on the farm, experiment with seed dispersal. Come and plant and return to harvest! Days led by experienced teachers.

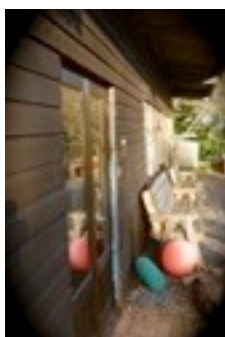
Prices start from £150, offers available for return visit.

Curriculum coverage, statutory requirements:

-  identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers
-  explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant
-  investigate the way in which water is transported within plants
-  explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.

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Forest and Beach is based at the Underwood Discovery Centre in Beeson. Directions: From Kingsbridge direction at Stokenham on the A379 take the right turn at the roundabout signposted to the lighthouse. After about a mile and a half there is a left turn to Beesands and Beeson. Take this turning and then take the immediate right. At the brow of the hill we are on the left.
